KENYA SAFARI

Day 01 – (Nairobi /Lake Nakuru National Park)

After breakfast, we will depart from the Kenya Safari Club and travel to Lake Nakuru National Park. Our 2 1/2 hour 170 km drive, will bring us south through Isiolo, crossing the northernmost foothills of Mount Kenya, until we arrive at the town of Nanyuki. Here you'll head west to Nyahururu, known to many as Thomson's Falls' which is the home of the 237 foot amazing water fall. During your journey to this beautiful Park, you will have the opportunity to enjoy stunning views of the vast and unique Kenya countryside.



Lake Nakuru is famous for its clouds of flamingos, Black Rhino's, as well its unusual tree climbing Lions. Over 1 million flamingos in the park literally turn the shores of Lake Nakuru pink.

This is a delight for ornithologists, scientists, and wildlife filmmakers. Lake Nakuru National Park covers 188 square kilometers of land, but has a great ecological diversity - from lake water,

Other exotic wildlife can be easily observed through-out the entire park. This wildlife includes Water Buffalo, Leopard, Lion, Rothschild's Giraffe, Black and White Colobus Monkey in the forests and animals like the Eland, Steinbok, Impala, Chandler's Reedbuck, and Dikdik in the Bushland. Finally, Rock Hyrax and the Klipspringer are found on the cliffs and escarpment.

Upon your arrival, you will be transferred to the Lake Nakuru Lodge where you will check-in and partake in a fantastic mid-day lunch. Following lunch, you will enjoy an afternoon game drive in our overland vehicle to savor the feast of wildlife on the lake's shores and on the cliffs of Lake Nakuru.



After the completion of your afternoon Safari drive, your guide will bring you back to THE Lake Nakuru Lodge where you will take pleasure in a delicious evening diner.

OVERNIGHT AT LAKE NAKURU LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 02 – (Lake Nakuru National Park / Masai Mara National Reserve)

After your early morning breakfast at the Lake Nakuru Lodge, you will depart the flamingo fringed Lake and proceed southward, turning right at Maai Mahiu to ascend up and over the top of the Mau Escarpment eventually arriving at the Masai Mara National Reserve. This adventurous drive is approximately 230 km's and will take 4 hours.

Outstanding in every way, the Masai Mara National Reserve is the most well known game park in Kenya and is located on the northern edge of the Serengeti Plain. Here you can see wide varieties and vast volumes of wildlife, 57 of the 450 recorded bird species are birds of prey. There are breathtaking areas of beautiful grasslands, rolling hills, wonderful acacia trees and a variety of lush bush areas.



Upon arrival at Masai Mara, your Safari Representative will drive you to the Masai Mara Sopa Lodge so you can check-in and enjoy an afternoon lunch followed by a game drive. The Mara Sopa Lodge is located on the furthestmost eastern corner of the Maasai Mara National Reserve and is situated near the Ololamutiek Gate.

Mara Sopa Lodge totally blends in perfectly with its surrounding hillside landscape; the Maasai people, fabulous wealth of wildlife, bird life, and natural flora to be found in the fabled Masai Mara National Reserve.

During your afternoon game drive, you most likely will see Cheetahs, Hyenas, Giraffes, Lions, Hippos, Leopards, Jackals, Wildebeests, Gazelles, Impalas, Topis, Hartebeests, Vultures, Eagles, Falcons, Ostriches, Zebras and much more. Following your afternoon adventure, you will return to the Sopa Lodge for a fantastic dinner.

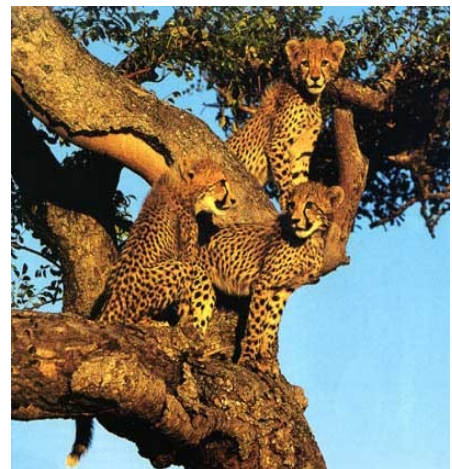
OVERNIGHT AT MASAI MARA SOPA LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 03 – (Masai Mara National Reserve)

Once you have completed your breakfast, you will once again venture out into this exciting National reserve. As you explore the savannah, you will see the mighty hunters returning from their nightly quest with their day's nourishment.

Upon the completion of your morning adventure, you will return to the Mara Sopa Lodge where you can relax for the rest of morning and early afternoon hours. Perhaps you might want to take a dip in the swimming pool, play a hand of Cards or just get to know some of your fellow Safari explorers. Later in the afternoon, you will return back to the savannah in search for members of the BIG 5 game family.



Due to the Sunset being short on the East African coast, you will return to the Lodge $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to the sun setting. However prior to your return, your Once In A Lifetime Safari Wildlife representative will try to position you for the most spectacular Serengeti Plain sunset event you will ever see. All meals will be served at the lodge

OVERNIGHT AT MASAI MARA SOPA LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 04 – (Maasai Mara Village / Masai Mara National Reserve)

After a leisurely breakfast, we will depart the Mara Sopa Lodge facility and travel a short distance to a unique Maasai Mara bushman village. The Maasai are a nomadic people and are known particularly noted for their handcrafted beadwork.

Male members of the tribe are herdsman and use cattle as capital to exchange for their necessities'. The Maasai diet consists of drinking a mix of cow's blood and milk along with other local delicacies.



Most of their food is obtain by young men hunting within the savannah plain with custom made spears. While the men of the tribe are out hunting, the women stay at the village and assist with the construction of their huts.

Young Maasai men leave the tribe at an early age and live off the land in small groups for several years. As they mature, it is the custom for many of them to become

warriors as part of their passage to adulthood.

On occasion, many of the young Maasai warriors stay living in the bush and become wild. It is well known that the Maasai tribes' people are very well versed on the local plants. Many species of the local vegetation is utilized for medical treatment of different ailments.

Once you have completed you visitation of the Maasai Village, we will return back to the Lodge for lunch. The remaining part of your afternoon will be at your leisure. At 16:00, we will journey back out to the Reserve for another beautiful late afternoon Safari adventure. All meals will be served at the Mara Sopa Lodge.

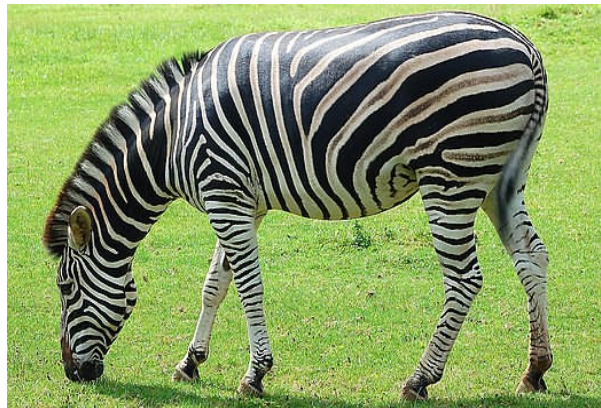
OVERNIGHT AT MARA SOPA LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 05 – (Masai Mara National Reserve / Nairobi)

With a 7:00 wakeup call, your breakfast will be waiting for you at the Sopa dining facility. Following breakfast, your guide will drive you back out into the Masai Mara Reserve where you will have one last opportunity to view the wonderful wildlife activity.

After your morning adventure, you will begin the journey back to Nairobi which will take 5 ½ hours due to the bumpy road conditions. Along the way, your Once In A Lifetime Safari representative will stop at a roadside Café for a mid-day lunch.



Following your arrival into Nairobi, your Once in A Lifetime Safari wildlife guide will transfer you to the Nairobi Safari Club for your over-night stay.

OVERNIGHT AT NAIROBI SAFARI CLUB

(B, L)

Day 6 – (Nairobi/Amboseli National Park)

At approximately 8:00 and after breakfast, your Once In A Lifetime Safari guide will meet you at the Nairobi Safari Club. You will then start your journey taking you south for approximately 250 kms across the beautiful and seemingly never ending Athi plains.



Once you turn east, you will be enter the Amboseli National Park which is located at the foot of majestic Mount Kilimanjaro, home to a wealth of wildlife but particularly known for its elephants. The total driving to Amboseli will take approximately 3 ½ hours.

As you enter the Park, you will notice the snowcapped peak of Kilimanjaro which dominates every aspect of Amboseli. This Park is one of Kenya's most famous National treasures. Amboseli only covers 392 sq km, but despite its small size and its fragile ecosystem,

it supports a wide range of mammals (well over 50 of the larger species) and birds (over 400 species).

Years ago, this was the locale around which such famous writers as Ernest Hemingway and Robert Ruark spun their stories of big-game hunting in the wilds of Africa. The snows of Mount Kilimanjaro, white and crystalline, form a majestic backdrop to one the region's most spectacular displays of wildlife - lion, elephant, leopard, rhino, cheetah, buffalo and hosts of plains' game, creating Kenya's most sought after photographer's paradise.

After completing your drive from Nairobi, you will arrive at the Sentrim Amboseli Lodge located in the heart of this wonderful National Park. Following check in, you will be able to relax and enjoy a delicious lunch served in the Sentrim Amboseli dining facility.

This luxurious tented lodge offers 60 modern tents with a private view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. The spacious tents boast the very latest in luxury camping with soft beds, an ensuite bathroom with a steaming hot shower. The bathroom also offers a washbasin and flush toilets. In the tent, we provide coffee and tea making facility, fridge, fan, hair drier and Electronic safe deposit boxes.



At approximately 3:00 and upon the completion of lunch, your Once In A Lifetime wildlife representative will escort you on an adventurous afternoon Safari drive. During your expedition, you will visit the nearby water-hole where you will observe an abundant of different wildlife species.

Upon the completion of your exciting afternoon adventure, you will return back to the Sentrim Lodge where your fabulous evening dinner will be served in the dining facility. Following dinner, you might opt to relax near the open camp-fire and enjoy a conversation with your fellow explorer.

OVERNIGHT AT SENTRIM AMBOSELI LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 7 – (Amboseli National Park)

After your hearty morning breakfast at the Sentrim Lodge, a full day will be spent exploring this most unique and wonderful National Park. One of the interesting and spectacular facts regarding the Amboseli National Park is its abundant and vast number of animal species.



During your morning and afternoon expedition, you will see Buffaloes, lions, gazelles, cheetahs, wildebeest, hyena, jackals, warthogs, zebras, Masai giraffes and baboons. Around the mid-day hour you will stop for a fantastic picnic lunch.

Following the return of your day's adventure, you might elect to relax in the Sentrim Amboseli Lodge's lounge area. This will provide you with the opportunity to enjoy a book or play a game of cards prior to your evening dinner.

After dinner, you might once again want to relax next to the open fire pit and discuss your day's

exploration with your fellow Safari adventurers.

OVERNIGHT AT SENTRIM AMBOSELI LODGE

(B, L, D)

Day 8 – (Amboseli National Park / Nairobi)

Once you have completed your breakfast, you will check-out of the Sentrim Lodge. Following check-out, your Safari Representative will once again drive you back into the Savannah for your final Safari adventure prior to returning back to Nairobi. The journey to Nairobi is approximately 250 km's and will take 3 ½ hours due to the bumpy road conditions.

Upon your arrival into Nairobi, you will finish your day by having a late Kenya farewell lunch at Africa's greatest "Eating experience", the Carnivore restaurant. This dining adventure will provide you an all you can eat Brazilian Churrasceria extravaganza of delicious meats served in a unique atmosphere. The Carnivore restaurant is know through-out the world and is considered to be Kenya's 2nd most popular destination after Maasai Mara.

After this wonderful late lunch, your agent will transfer you to the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and bid you farewell.
